The successful candidate will have experience in assembly line work and be able to work quickly and accurately. The Assembler will be responsible for following instructions, using tools correctly, and ensuring that all products meet safety and quality standards. Attention to detail and a commitment to excellence are essential for this role.

This is an on-site hourly position from June to mid-October 2024 and requires a presence at our Cle Elum, Washington facility. There is flexibility in establishing a set schedule, for up to 30 hours per week between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
